



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

In Windsor, few names are as synonymous with style and quality as FREEDS. What started as a modest department store in 1929 has become a pillar in the local community, known for their expertly tailored suits, and their deep-rooted family legacy. It all began with Sam Freed, a man with an incredible gift for business, and today, his legacy lives on through his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren, who continue to carry the torch.

By 1936, Sam's family expanded with the birth of his son, Gerald, who, after working in the store from a young age, would eventually take over the business and carry it to new heights.

"Over time, there was just a natural growth," says Gerald when asked about FREEDS earlier days. "There was a lot of competition as we started. There were 15 or 16 suits stores in Windsor that we were competing with. And as time went on, and there were changes in the economy, and to some degree, the way people dressed, the competition seemed to erode, and we were getting stronger and doing quite well, and it was a good run as we went up the ladder and had a very good relationship with our suppliers."





As the business thrived, so did the family. Gerald's brother-in-law, Alan Orman, joined the company in the 1960s as a co-owner, and by 1971 FREEDS rebranded, becoming the triumphant clothing store the entire region knows today.

By the 1980s, the next generation was stepping into the family business. Gerald's son, Ari Freed, and Alan's son, Dan Orman, began working at the store, learning the business from the ground up.

"I started working here when I was about 7 or 8 years old, folding boxes during Christmas breaks and working part-time through high school," Dan remembers. "I have so many memories of working alongside my father."

Ari and Dan, driven by the same passion as their fathers, worked hard to grow FREEDS while staying true to the company's core values: quality products and exceptional customer service. These values remained at the heart of every decision they made as they eventually took over as co-owners with their fathers' support.

Although Ari had always been passionate about business, he wasn't sure he would follow in his father's footsteps. After high school, he attended York University to study economics and completed an additional two years at the University of Windsor where he earned his Master of Business Administration. It was during his second year in Toronto that he realized he couldn't picture himself behind a desk.

"I needed interaction with people," Ari said. "I thought back to my high school days and FREEDS. I thought to myself, what better opportunity than to join my family? My father never pushed me into the business. He always left it as a choice for me. I called him up to tell him I wanted to join the family business, and he was so happy to hear me say those words."

Ari and Dan's partnership, much like that of their fathers, has proven to be a powerful force behind FREEDS' continued success. Both men entered the business at a young age, learning from the ground up, working in different departments, and slowly developing a deep understanding of what it takes to run a retail operation as respected as FREEDS.
















The year 2018 marked another important milestone for FREEDS as Dan and Ari formally signed on as co-owners, following in their fathers' footsteps. At the same time, the fourth generation-Ari's sons Evan and Derek-joined the family business.

Evan oversees a little bit of everything, with a diverse array of responsibilities including marketing, e-commerce, and more, all while maintaining an active presence on the floor. Derek, like his father Ari before him, has the very important role of managing FREEDS famous suit department and is an active presence on the floor, carrying forward the family's expertise in men's fashion. The brothers also jointly manage a significant portion of purchasing for the store, curating a wide selection ranging from athleisure-wear by Vuori to formal attire by Jack Victor.

While Evan and Derek are now both an integral part of the business, it wasn't initially part of the plan. Both of the brothers previously had promising careers outside of it. Derek previously received his business degree at Michigan State University and worked for several years in the hospitality field. Evan earned his degree from the University of Michigan, then attended Southwestern Law School ultimately becoming an entertainment attorney in Los Angeles.

"I never planned on joining the family business," Evan reflects on the unexpected shift in his career path. "Growing up, Derek and I were encouraged to work summer jobs outside of the story.

We loved the store and always enjoyed our time there, but the idea of us working in the business was something that we never discussed. My dad called me one day and asked how I felt about being in California long term and if I was interested in the opportunity of Derek and I coming into the business. It was a big phone call and it took me a bit by surprise. Derek and I are best friends, so the more we discussed it, the more we became excited about the opportunity of working together and pushing the business forward."

After this phone call, Evan realized he did, in fact, always found Freeds interesting. He felt a curiosity from the outside looking in and decided, with Derek at his side, that it was the right thing to do, and the brothers have never looked back. Just as Ari wasn't pressured to join the family business, neither were his sons. The decision to continue the legacy was theirs to make, and that autonomy has allowed each generation to bring its own passion and perspective into FREEDS, enriching the company's culture and driving its success forward.












